Welcome back to school- we hope you had a lovely Easter break. Our main topic is Saint-Saëns' Carnival of the Animals with a focus on art and music. Here is a summary of the topics we will be covering this term.



Literacy - Read Write Inc. for Year 1 and 'Big Writing' for Year 2 linked to our topics. This will include stories, non-fiction and poetry.

Maths - Counting and place value, ordering numbers, word problems, estimating, addition and subtraction, 2-D and 3-D shapes, measuring, making and using charts and tables, telling the time, finding fractions, multiplying and dividing.

Science - Plants and animals including humans

PHSE - Physical health and SRE

Computing - Using Apps such as Lego Movie Maker and Book Creator to support learning across the curriculum

Topic (incorporating History, Music, Art and DT) - Carnival of the Animals. We will focus on learning about birds of prey, fish and fossils around the world.

Geography - Map skills and fieldwork

RE - Who is Jewish and what do they believe?

PE - Multiskills and athletics



Don't forget to keep reading every night and recording this in the back of the home liaison book. PE lessons will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays; Forest School will restart once the Forest School area is back in use - we will let you know when this is.
