Welcome back to school, and a special welcome to the new members of Class 2.

Our main topic is 'Foods from round the world', and the new theme for the Class 2 role play area is 'The Farm Shop'. Here is a summary of the topics we will be covering this term.



Literacy - Read Write Inc. phonics, spelling and grammar focus: classic fiction, letters, instructions, poetry.

Maths Counting and place value, ordering numbers, word problems, estimating, addition and subtraction, 2-D and 3-D shapes, measuring, making and using charts and tables, telling the time, finding fractions, grouping into 2s, 5s and 10s.

Science - Uses of everyday materials/ seasonal changes

PHSE - Caring for ourselves, our pets, other people and the environment. Citizenship.

Computing - Understanding algorithms, creating digital content

Geography - Comparing our local area with rural Ghana

History - The history of the local area

Art - Weaving inspired by Kente cloth

DT - Cooking - recipes from the UK (scones) and Africa (bread)

RE - Belonging to a faith community. (Judaism)

PE - Gymnastics, dance and multiskills

Music - African songs and rhythms



Don't forget to keep reading every night and recording this in the back of the home liaison book. PE lessons will take place on Mondays and Thursdays. Homework will be given out on Fridays and must be handed in by the following Thursday. If you have any queries put a note in the home liaison book - these are checked every day.
