I am very excited to be starting this new academic year and wanted to outline the areas of the curriculum that we will be studying over the course of the Autumn Term. Our topic for this term is Rainforests. We will be investigating all there is to know about Rainforests around the world, including location, people, animals, products and food. We will also be finding out why preserving the Rainforests is so important to all of us.

The areas of focus for this term are as follows:

- Literacy Fiction-Stories by the same author, using poetry to create images, exploring Non-fiction by writing instructions and explanations, stories from other cultures and letter writing.
- Numeracy Number and place value, addition and subtraction, shape and the properties of shapes, multiplication and division, money, time, bar charts and pictograms and fractions.

- Computing Sequencing and animation.
