Dear Parents/Carers,

On Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June, Class 5 will be visiting London to explore British cultures and experience our capital city. As you will know, it is a long drive and in order to achieve our fun-packed schedule, we need to leave earlier than usual. Therefore, we ask that children arrive at school for 6:30am and the coach <u>will</u> leave at 6:45am. We will then return to school for 8:00pm and therefore ask that children be picked up at this later time, please. Children can then come in at 10:30am the following day. If they cannot come in at that later time, then they <u>must</u> come in at 8:45am as normal.

The day consists of a visit to the Natural History Museum (<u>https://www.nhm.ac.uk/</u>) and relishing life as a super tourist as they hop on the Thames Clipper, experience a tube ride and wave at iconic sights such as the London Eye, Downing Street and Buckingham Palace. Yes, we will snap lots of photos!

Children will need to wear smart school uniform including their red jumper (not grey leavers hoodie) and preferably, a light waterproof jacket that would fit in their bag. However, they are allowed to wear trainers on this occasion as we will be walking at points. They will need to bring a small backpack containing a packed lunch, a water bottle and several healthy snacks. They can also bring some money to spend on an ice-cream, at a souvineer stall or in the NHM gift shop. If you require a packed lunch from the school caterers please ensure this is ordered by the end of Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June.

The charge for this trip will be £30, in order to cover the cost of the coach, boat and tube. We will need to cover these costs in order for the trip to run. If the cost of the trip is prohibitive, then please contact me at school to discuss alternative funding.
