Oak Class

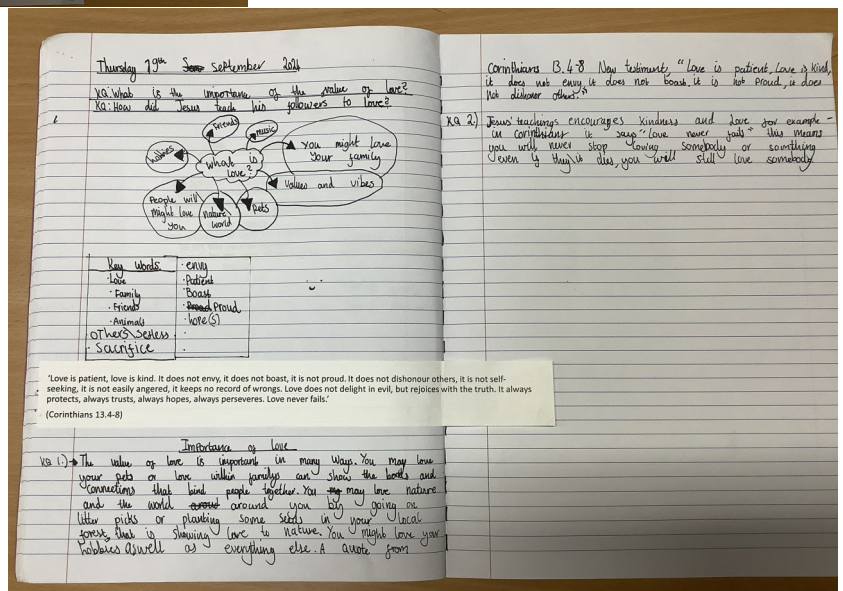
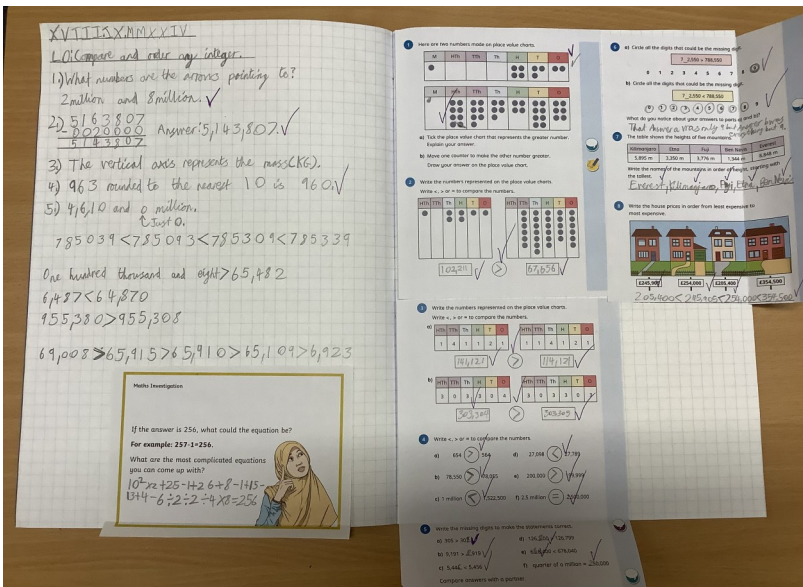
We have had another brilliant week in Oak Class!

In Maths, we have been developing our understanding of place-value in which we have been comparing and ordering numbers.

In English, we are reading the book, 'Star of Fear, Star of Hope', which offers a gentle way to introduce the difficult topic of the Holocaust. I have been delighted with the high-quality writing that the children have produced and their emotional sensitivity when discussing such a serious subject.

In Science, Year Six have been developing their understanding of the circulatory system, while Year Five have been exploring the difference between weight and mass, investigating prominent thinkers such as Newton and Galileo.

In RE this week, we discussed the questions: 'What is the importance of the value of love' and 'How did Jesus teach his followers to love'. I was most impressed by the high-level discussions and how they interpreted a passage from Corinthians.

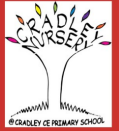

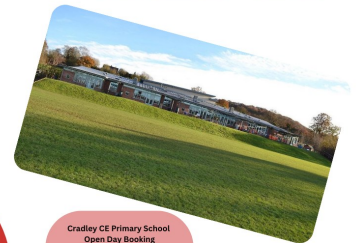
