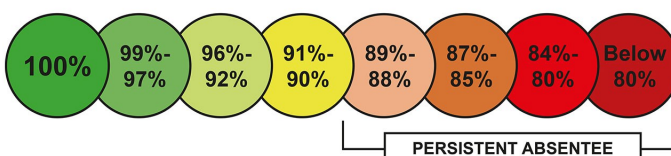

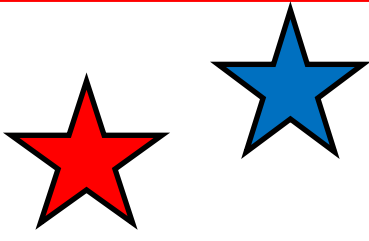

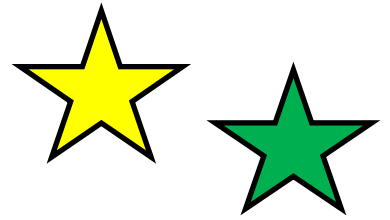

Sycamore Class have had a great first week back.



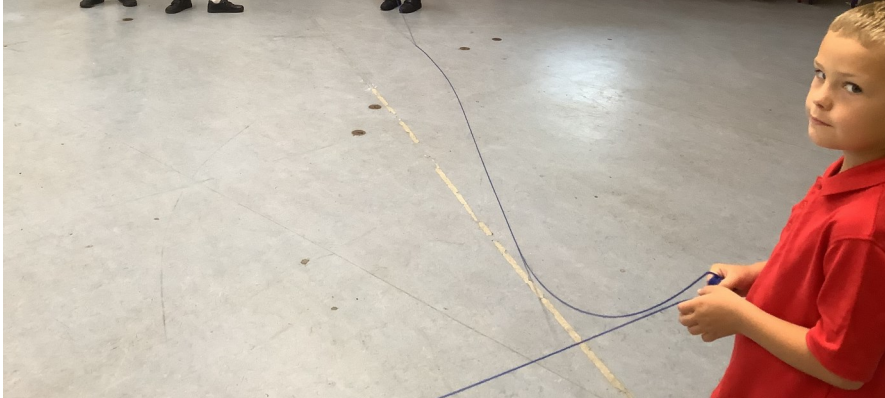
A busy first week for Class 2, who have settled back in well. We have had great fun getting to know each other and made a flying start with our learning.
